The leaves of this trailing vine are used in traditional Samoan medicines. This vine is also known as beach morning glory. It grows quickly and forms large mats that help to stabilize sand and prevent erosion. It withstands salt spray and recovers after being flooded by ocean water during storms. It is not an invasive vine; it is native to Samoa.
