- Improve communication and collaboration in adaptation initiatives by national and international stakeholders

Plan of Action

- Start simple
- Build on existing regional initiatives by forming partnerships with CC partners e.g UNDP, SPC, GIZ, NOAA, NIWA to avoid duplication
- Learn from best practices – PDN, PRISM etc
- Create Climate Change Information Network
- Carry out User Needs Survey
- Information is timely, correct and relevant to the Pacific
- Establish Portal Governance Committee
