Palau PACC Mainstreaming

Gap Analysis → Food Security Policy

-informed by the following processes/initiatives

- □ Sustainable Land Management Policy for Palau (April 2012)
- National Building Code Legislation (not passed yet)
- □ Palau Water & Sanitation Policy (April 2012)
- □ Palau National Disaster Risk Management Framework (March 2012)











Mainstreaming...Rationale

- □ Palau PACC Core Group key stakeholder in initiatives
- ☐ The food security gap analysis was made possible through the original efforts listed below:
 - Development of national policies and frameworks provide vision, direction, coordination
 - Development of national building code standards to address implications on designated agri/aquaculture zones.
 - Establishment of guiding principles –address the needs of vulnerable populations and the unique impacts they face with regard to local food production

 - Gender Assessment (part of SLM Policy)
 - Capacity Assessment (part of SLM Policy)
 - Nation-wide Socioeconomic Assessment
 - Nation-wide GIS Farm Survey
- Key stakeholder Consultations
 - NGOs & CBOs who work directly with communities
 - Council of Chiefs
 - Governor's Association
 - Farmer's Associations (Ekei Women's Group, Palau Organic Farmers Assoc, etc)
